

The University of Portsmouth Lacrosse Club - Women's Coach

Purpose of the Role

The University of Portsmouth Lacrosse Club are looking to recruit a coach to lead the delivery of training sessions for their Women's team, who compete in the BUCS South Eastern Tier 2A league, against other Universities. The successful candidate will be available to deliver weekly training sessions, it would be desirable for them to manage the match day squad at fixtures, but not mandatory.

Training sessions take place:

- Tuesdays, 4pm - 6pm at Langstone Campus, Furze Lane
- Saturdays, 4pm - 6pm at Langstone Campus, Furze Lane (TBC)

It is only necessary for the coach to attend one training session per week

Fixtures take place on Wednesday afternoons, at varying locations.

Main Responsibilities:

- Plan, deliver and evaluate a weekly training session for club members
- Attend fixtures and manage the team where possible
- Enhance the club's organisation by providing guidance on self-lead training sessions
- Communicate regularly and effectively with Team Captain regarding team selection
- Promote the club's philosophy to all members
- Adhere to the University's Code of Conduct

Criteria:

- Essential: Level 1 coaching qualification
- Essential: Previous playing experience
- Essential: Good organisation skills
- Desirable: Level 2 coaching qualification
